



HOW TO APPLY?



Admission into **Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT)** will be conducted based on the score of CEE as per the guidelines of Assam State Allied Health Council and **PG programmes will be based on AWUET-2026 examination/CUET (PG)**. Details of the examination will be notified on the university website, and candidates are advised to visit <https://awu.ac.in> frequently.

Admission into **Diploma** programme will be purely on merit basis following the reservation system of the Government of Assam.

Online Application for **BPT, PG** and **Diploma** programmes are invited by visiting <https://admission.awu.ac.in> with a nominal application fee of ₹ 600.00 + **Service Charge**. It is Non-refundable. (No hard copy of application will be accepted)

Candidates seeking admission into **Integrated Post Graduate (PG) programme** shall have to apply through Assam Higher Education Admission web portal at <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in>

- The Admission cum Counselling Form for Integrated PG programmes of Assam Women's University is available at <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in>/web portal.
- Candidates need to register online to get Login-id and Password.
- Candidate should fill up the Admission cum Counselling Form and choose Assam Women's University for their desired programme.

1. THE UNIVERSITY

The Assam Women's University is the first state women University in the entire North Eastern Region of India which started functioning from the month of September, 2014. The University has been established by an Act (XXII) of 2013 of State Legislature of Assam as a State University vide Notification LGL.149/2011/92 dated 21.08.2013 and is empowered to award degrees as specified by the UGC under Section 22 of the UGC Act 1956 through its own departments. The main objectives of the University are as follows.

- a) To provide for facilities and offer opportunities to women for education in applied arts, technology, industry, commerce, management, applied sciences and social science by instruction, training, research, development and by such other means as the University may deem fit;
- b) To promote research in applied science and arts, technology, industry, commerce, management and social science for the advancement of knowledge

and for the betterment of the society particularly with focus on women's perspective;

- c) To devise and implement programmes of education for women in applied science, arts, technology, industry, commerce, management and social science that are relevant to the changing socio-economic needs of the society, in terms of breadth of diversity and depth of specialisation;
- d) To serve as a centre for fostering co-operation and exchange of ideas between the academic and research community on the one hand and industry on the other;

9. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

During the session 2026-27, Assam Women's University offers one (1) diploma, one (1) under graduate, fifteen (15) Integrated PG programmes and sixteen (16) post-graduate programmes. Intake capacity for each programme will be of forty-seven (47) Regular Seats (*except Integrated PG programmes which have 48 Regular Seats and 02 Supernumerary Seats - One for Employees of Assam Women's University and the other seat for students of periphery villages*) and six (6) Endowment (High-Fee) Category Seats followed by two (2) Supernumerary Seats (*One for Employees of Assam Women's University and the other seat for students of periphery villages*).

Admission into **Integrated PG programmes**, all the seats shall be filled up on merit basis, based on best of five subject marks secured by the candidate in the (10+2) examination following the reservation system of the Government of Assam. **Candidates seeking admission into Integrated PG and Bachelor programmes shall have to apply through Assam Higher Education Admission web portal at <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>.**

a) **Only female candidates are eligible for admission.**

b) A candidate applying for undergraduate or Integrated PG programme shall have to be at least 17 years of age as on August 1, 2026 (i.e., must have been born before 01-08-2009).

Admission into **Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT)** will be conducted based on the score of CEE as per the guidelines of Assam State Allied Health Council and **PG programmes will be based on AWUET-2026 examination/CUET (PG)**. Details of the examination will be notified in the website. Candidates are advised to visit the university website www.awu.ac.in frequently.



Admission into **Diploma programme** will be purely on merit basis following the reservation system of the Government of Assam. **Online applications** for **BPT**, **PG** and **Diploma** programmes are available at <https://admission.awu.ac.in> by paying a nominal application / entrance fee of ₹ **600.00** (*Six Hundred only*) + Service Charge. This fee is non-refundable.

N.B.: 1. A relaxation of 5% marks shall be applicable for SC/ST candidates. (In case of BPT, the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes (NCL), the minimum marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology are taken together in the qualifying examination shall be 40% marks instead of 50% marks for Unreserved and General-EWS Candidates.)

9.1. PROCEDURE FOR HOLDING AWU ENTRANCE TEST-2026

- a) The Assam Women's University Entrance Test (AWUET-2026) shall take place at Kaliapani, Teok campus of Assam Women's University.
- b) For **Bachelor of Physiotherapy**, questions will be on Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English from 10+2 level syllabus. The qualifying marks of the entrance test for the Department of Physiotherapy is 50%.
- c) For **PG programmes**, the mode of selection will be based on Assam Women's University Entrance Test (AWUET) to be notified on a later date. Candidates are advised to visit the university website frequently.
- d) The final merit list will be prepared based on the academic performance of the candidate and the marks scored in the entrance examinations conducted by the respective departments.

10. SELECTION & ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Candidates will have to appear personally before the Selection Committee (subject to change) at their own expense, on the scheduled date of admission.

10.1. RESERVATION OF SEATS

The University makes provisions for reservation of seats as per Government of Assam norms for eligible candidates





belonging to the following categories. Certificates from the competent authorities against each of the reserved categories must be enclosed along with the filled-in application form. Self-attested copies of certificates mentioned against each of the categories must be submitted along with the online application form, the original of which has to be produced at the time of admission.

- a) Scheduled Caste specified in relation to the state of Assam under Article 341 of the Constitution of India. (Certificate from the competent authority countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner / Additional Deputy Commissioner).
- b) Scheduled Tribes (Plains and Hills) specified in relation to the state of Assam under Article 342 of the Constitution of India. (Certificate from competent authority countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner / Additional Deputy Commissioner).
- c) Other Backward Classes (OBC) / More Other Backward Classes (OBC) specified in relation to the state of Assam. (Certificate from competent authority countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner / Additional Deputy Commissioner).

- d) Persons with Disabilities as per provisions of Section 32 under Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016. (Certificate from competent authority countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner / Additional Deputy Commissioner).

10.2. ADMISSION OF FOREIGN / NRI STUDENTS

Foreign candidate seeking admission shall forward their application through their respective Embassy / Mission at New Delhi or through the respective Indian Missions abroad to the Government of India / University Grants Commission (UGC) and their candidature shall be considered if they are sponsored / cleared by the Government of India / UGC. Necessary fees shall be charged at the rates prescribed by the UGC for the foreign candidates which is three times of the admission fees in each semester for the respective discipline. Eligibility for admission of foreign students is as per qualification prescribed by the University. A good knowledge of English language is essential. In addition to this, students are required to be registered in the Education India portal (<https://educationindia.gov.in/>).



10.3. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION OF FOREIGN / NRI STUDENTS

- a) Visa: All the international students will require a student visa endorsed to this Institution for joining full time courses. No other endorsement is acceptable. The visa should be valid for the prescribed duration of the course. Visa is not required for NRI students.
- b) All international students will have to obtain prior security clearance from the Ministry of Home Affairs and the approval of Department of Secondary & Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development Government of India.
- c) A certificate of candidates' proficiency in English issued by the respective Indian Mission abroad and recognized agencies should be submitted.
- d) EII Registration Certificate/Receipt.

10.4. ADMISSION

Admission of a candidate to a Programme is subject to the following conditions:

- a) Fulfilment of the eligibility criteria as specified in Eligibility Criteria for Admission.
- b) Selection for admission to the Programme.
- c) Production of all the relevant documents such as pass certificates and marksheets of all earlier examinations with requisite percentage of marks in original and original copies of documents uploaded at the time of submission of the application form.
- d) Submission of a set of self-attested copy of all pass certificate, marksheets and other the relevant documents.
- e) Submission of the character certificate from the Head of the Institution and Migration certificate (in original) from the Board / University last attended.
- f) **Receipt of payment of admission fee in full.**

10.5. PROVISIONAL ADMISSION

- a) If the result of the qualifying examination of a student is awaited at the time of admission, she must produce/submit pass certificate/marksheet with requisite percentage of marks within

30th October, 2026. Such a candidate must submit a proof of taking all the examinations including practical/lab/project/backlog courses of the qualifying Degree/Diploma/Certificate at the time of admission duly certified by the Head of the Institute last attended. If any backlog course or other component remains incomplete after admission, then the candidate will be treated as not qualified for continuation and will be asked to leave the programme.

- b) If a candidate fails to produce / submit any document (such as the completion certificate and mark sheet/transcripts of the qualifying examinations, migration certificate from the Board/University last attended, etc.) at the time of admission, the same must be produced as early as possible but not later than **30th October, 2026.**
- c) Candidates failing to produce marksheet or pass certificate with requisite percentage of marks within the specified period will not be allowed to continue her study.



10.6. GAP PERIOD CERTIFICATE

If a candidate discontinues her studies after the qualifying examination, she shall have to furnish a gap period certificate only from the institute last attended at the time of admission.

10.7. PHYSICAL FITNESS CERTIFICATE

The candidate shall have to submit a duly filled-in prescribed format (*Annexure-1*) at the time of admission.

10.8. ANTI-RAGGING AFFIDAVITS

Indulging in ragging inside or outside the University campus is punishable. Students are advised to visit www.ugc.ac.in or www.awu.ac.in for UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009. Anti-Ragging Undertaking must be filled by the students online at <http://www.antiragging.in> only after taking admission to Assam Women's University. As per the direction of UGC, Universities/Colleges will not accept anti-ragging undertakings by students in Hard/Printed copies/Affidavits.

10.9. PAYMENT OF FEES

Subject to physical fitness of the candidates, being declared as such by the Medical Officer / Medical Board, an eligible candidate has to take admission on payment of prescribed fees immediately after selection. **Fee Waiver scheme is applicable for candidates who have valid Ration card.**

14. TEACHING

14.1. CBCS & CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT

The AWU has followed the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) and Continuous Assessment in a semester in consonance with NEP 2020. These are the important components of reform in higher education in India. In this Choice based credit system, students are given opportunities to pursue courses of interest across discipline and schools in addition to their major course of interest.

The number of credits in a course is closely related to the number of teaching-learning hours and the flexible curriculum enables students to pursue courses of their interest and obtain inter-disciplinary expertise. Assam Women's University has also adopted the Lecture-Tutorial-Practical (L-T-P) structure which encourages students towards self-learning or learner centric approaches. The students have more opportunities to develop and nurture their creative abilities and are exposed to the methodologies of academic work.

Medium of Instruction is **English & Assamese**.

14.2. ACADEMIC YEAR

The academic year of the University is from August to July. The academic year consists of two semesters.

14.3. COURSES

During a semester, the students register themselves for a number of courses. A "Course" is a unit of instruction of a subject matter under any discipline carrying a specific number of "Credit Hours".

14.4. CREDIT HOURS

"Credit Hours" Signify the quantum of work done corresponding to 1 hour of theory class or 2-3 hours of laboratory /field practical every week during a semester in respect of a particular course.

14.5. ATTENDANCE

Minimum attendance of a student shall be followed as per the rules prescribed in the Assam Women's University Student Charter.



15. EXAMINATION

Student performance for both Under Graduate (UG) and Post Graduate (PG) program shall be monitored throughout the semester by continuous assessment. There shall be university examinations (both theory and practical) at the end of each semester. But a continuous evaluation of students will be carried out by the course teachers during the progress of semester. The evaluation scheme for each course shall contain the following two parts.

- a) Internal evaluation carried out during the semester.
- b) External evaluation at the end of the semester.

Internal evaluation shall involve two written tests as notified in the academic calendar. External paper setters are engaged for external evaluation, i.e., end term examination.

16. CLIMATE

The climate of the state is pleasant for most part of the year. The winter lasts for about five months, viz., from October to February. Though summer starts from March-

April, the weather is quite pleasant. There is heavy rainfall during the months of July and August.

17. DISCIPLINE

All students are to maintain discipline and proper scholastic atmosphere during their stay at the University. On admission, students must acquaint themselves with the University and hostel rules and regulations. Ragging is completely banned in Assam Women's University. Any student found involved in ragging shall be liable for stern disciplinary action as per the UGC Regulation on "*Curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institution, 2009*".

18. STUDENTS' WELFARE

18.1. SPORTS, RECREATION & SOCIAL SERVICE

The University shall gradually provide facilities for games and sports, music, study circle, drama and other co-curricular activities for overall personality development of the students admitted.

18.2. MEDICAL FACILITIES

The University presently has an ambulance which is available 24x7 to facilitate students in commuting to and from the university campus and JMCH, Jorhat in cases of emergency. First Aid Care is available. Additionally, an OPD clinic under the Department of Physiotherapy will be available soon.

18.3. STUDENTS MAGAZINE

Assam Women's University publishes annual magazine to encourage creativity of the students. The students are to pay the magazine fee at the beginning of each academic year.

18.4. BUS FACILITY

Bus service is available for commuting between Jorhat Town and University Campus in scheduled times.

19. REFUND OF CAUTION MONEY

Refund of caution money shall be made to a student after her release from the University. The claim of caution money shall not be entertained beyond a period of one year from the date of release.

Release of caution money shall be made against application in prescribed form and production of release order. The caution money shall not be refunded if a student leaves the university without prior permission and/or does not join and attend any class after admission.

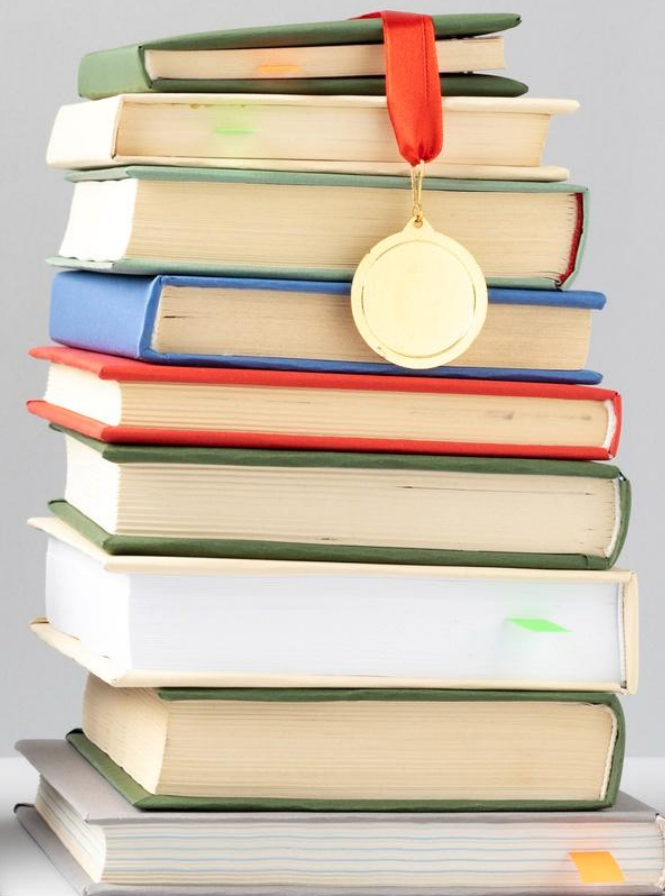
